## **Sunday 28 February**

- **Moderator** | The Moderator's Appeal for help towards the support of some PCI mission partners will provide much needed help in situations of desperate emergency. Please pray for the continuing safety of our mission partners as they carry out vital relief work in challenging circumstances.
